

Data Privacy Statement

§ 1 Information about collecting personal data

- (1) In the following we would like to inform you about collecting personal data when visiting our website. Personal data are all data which are personally obtainable from you, for example, name, address, e-mail addresses, user behaviour.
- (2) The company Deloro Wear Solutions GmbH is the responsible party according to Art. 4 (7) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (DS-GVO) (see our imprint). You can reach our data protection officer under datenschutz@deloro.com or our postal address with the addition "Der Datenschutzbeauftragte".
- (3) When you contact us by e-mail or through a contact form, the information you provide (your e-mail address, your name and telephone number if applicable) will be stored by us to answer your questions. We delete the data that arises in this context after the storage is no longer required or limit the processing if there are statutory retention requirements.
- (4) If we use contracted service providers for individual functions of our offer or if we wish to use your data for advertising purposes, we will inform you in detail below about the respective transactions. In doing so, we also name the specified criteria for the storage duration.

§ 2 Your rights

- (1) You have the following rights with respect to the personal data concerning you:
 - the right to information,
 - the right to rectification or erasure,
 - the right to restriction of processing,
 - the right to object to the processing,
 - the right to data portability.
- (2) You also have the right to lodge a complaint about us regarding the processing of your personal data to a data protection supervisory authority.

§ 3 Collection of personal data when visiting our website

- (1) If simply using the website for information, if you do not register or otherwise provide us with information, we will only collect the personal data that your browser transmits to our server. If you wish to view our website, we collect the following data, which is technically necessary to show you our website and to ensure stability and security (legal basis is Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 DS-GVO):
 - IP address
 - date and time of the enquiry
 - time zone difference to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
 - Contents of the request (concrete page)
 - access status/HTTP status code
 - each transmitted amount of data
 - the website where the request came from
 - browser

- Operating system and its interface
- Language and version of the browser software.

- (2) In addition to the data, cookies are stored on your computer when you use our website if you give us your consent.

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your hard drive as associated with the browser you are using and through which certain information flows to the place that sets the cookie. Cookies cannot run programs or transmit viruses to your computer. They are used to make the Internet offer more user-friendly and effective overall.

- (3) Use of cookies:

On the one hand, we use technically necessary cookies. These cookies are necessary for the good functionality of our website and cannot be turned off in our system. The legal basis is Article 6 (1) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (DS-GVO) ('legitimate interest'). You can of course configure your browser setting according to your wishes and reject such technically necessary cookies. We would like to point out that you will not be able to use our website.

Otherwise, Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 according DS-GVO legal basis for the use of cookies ("consent"). You can differentiate whether you give us consent for all cookies, only in relation to certain types of cookies (e.g., functional cookies, performance cookies, advertising/tracking cookies) or no consent at all.

This consent is voluntary. You can refuse them without giving reasons, without fear of any disadvantages. You can also revoke this consent at any time with future effects here on www.deloro.com under "Cookie Settings" in the footer, without any disadvantages. However, we would like to point out that if you do not give your consent or if you withdraw, you may not be able to use all features of this site.

§ 4 Further features and offers of our website

- (1) In addition to the purely informational use of our website, we offer various services that you can use if you are interested. To do this, you will generally need to provide other personal information that we use to provide the service and for which the aforementioned data processing principles apply.
- (2) To some extent we use external service providers to process your data. These have been carefully selected by us, reviewed and commissioned regarding the applicable data protection standards, are subject to our instructions and are regularly inspected.
- (3) Furthermore, we can pass on your personal data to third parties if contracts or similar services are offered by us with partners. For more information, please refer to your personal data or below in the description of the offer.

§ 5 Opposition or revocation against the processing of your data

- (1) If you have given your consent to the processing of your data, you can revoke it at any time. Such revocation affects the admissibility of the processing of your personal data after you have given it to us.
- (2) Insofar as we base the processing of your personal data on an assessment of interests, you can file an objection to the processing. This is the case if, in particular, the processing is not required to fulfill a contract with you, which we will present in the following description of the functions. In the event of any such disagreement, we ask you to explain the reasons why we should not process your personal data. In the case of a justified objection, we will examine the situation and will either discontinue or adapt the data processing or point out to you our compelling legitimate reasons why we will continue the processing.

- (3) Of course, you may object to the processing of your personal data for advertising and data analysis purposes at any time. You can inform us about your objections to advertising under the following contact details: datenschutz@deloro.com.

§ 6 Use of Google Analytics

- (1) This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. ("Google").

We use Google Analytics to analyze and regularly improve the use of our website. Through the statistics obtained, we can improve our offer and make it more interesting for you as a user.

Google Analytics uses cookies, i.e., text files, which are stored on your computer and which enable an analysis of your use of the website.

Google also processes your personal data in the United States. Before giving your consent in accordance with Art. 49(1) lit. a DS-GVO, we would like to point out in particular that there may not be an adequate level of data protection in the USA without the existence of an adequacy decision and without appropriate guarantees, since data protection laws do not comply with the requirements of the DS-GVO, in particular data subjects' rights may not be enforced.

- (2) The setting of cookies only takes place if you give us your consent. The legal basis is Art. 6(1) sentence 1 lit. a DS-GVO ("Consent"). This consent is voluntary. You can refuse them without giving reasons, without fear of any disadvantages. You can also revoke this consent at any time with future effect on www.deloro.com under "Cookie Settings" in the footer without threatening you with any disadvantages.
- (3) The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website is usually transmitted to a Google server in the USA and stored there. However, if IP anonymization is activated on this website, your IP address will be truncated by Google within Member States of the European Union or in other contracting states of the Agreement on the European Economic Area.
- (4) This website uses Google Analytics with the "_anonymizelp" extension. As a result, IP addresses are processed in a truncated manner, which can be used to exclude personal data. Insofar as the data collected about you is subject to a personal reference, this is immediately excluded, and the personal data is deleted immediately. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be transmitted to a Google server in the USA and truncated there.
- (5) On behalf of the operator of this website, Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compile reports on website activity and provide other services relating to website activity and internet usage to the website operator.

The IP address transmitted by your browser within the scope of Google Analytics will not be merged with other data from Google.

§ 7 Use of social-media-plug-ins

- (1) We currently use the following social media plug-ins: You Tube. We use the so-called two-click solution. In other words, when you visit our site, initially no personal data is passed on to the providers of the plug-ins. The provider of the plug-in can be recognized by the marking on the box above the first letter or the logo. We give you the opportunity to communicate directly with the provider of the plug-in via the button. Only if you click on the highlighted field and activate it, will the plug-in provider receive the

information that you have accessed the corresponding website of our online service. In addition, the data referred to in § 3 of this declaration will be transmitted. In the case of Facebook and Xing, according to the respective providers in Germany, the IP address is anonymized immediately after collection. By activating the plug-in, personal data will be transmitted by you to the respective plug-in provider and stored there (with US providers in the USA). Since the plug-in provider carries out the data collection, in particular via cookies, we recommend that you delete all cookies before clicking on the greyed-out box via the security settings of your browser.

- (2) We have neither influence on the collected data and data processing operations, nor are we aware of the full extent of the data collection, the purpose of processing or the retention periods. We also have no information about deleting the data collected by the plug-in provider.
- (3) The plug-in provider stores the data collected about you as usage profiles and uses them for advertising, market research and / or tailor-made website design purposes. Such an evaluation is carried out in particular (also for non-logged-in users) for the presentation of needs-based advertising and to inform other users of the social network about your activities on our website. You have the right to file an objection to the formation of these user profiles, whereby you must contact the respective plug-in provider to exercise this. Through the plug-ins, we offer you the opportunity to interact with social networks and other users so that we can improve our services and make it more interesting for you, the user. The legal basis for the use of the plug-ins is Art. 6(1) sentence 1 lit. f DS-GVO.
- (4) The data transfer takes place regardless of whether you have an account with the plug-in provider and are logged in there or not. If you are logged into the plug-in provider, your data collected from us will be assigned directly to your existing account with the plug-in provider. If you press the activated button and, for example, you link the page, the plug-in provider also stores this information in your user account and shares it publicly with your contacts. We recommend that you log out regularly after using a social network, and especially before activating the button, as this will prevent you from being assigned to your profile with the plug-in provider.

Only when you play the videos will the above data be transferred. We have no influence on this data transfer.
- (2) By visiting the website, YouTube receives the information that you have accessed the corresponding subpage of our website. In addition, the data mentioned in this declaration are transmitted under "Purpose of processing personal data when visiting our website". This is done regardless of whether YouTube provides a user account through which you are logged in or whether there is no user account. If you are logged in to Google, your data will be directly associated with your account. If you do not want to be assigned to your profile on YouTube, you must log out before activating the button. YouTube stores your data as user profiles and uses it for advertising, market

research and/or needs-based design of its website. Such an evaluation is carried out in particular (even for unlogged users) for the provision of demand-oriented advertising and to inform other users of the social network about your activities on our website. You have the right to object to the creation of these user profiles, whereby you must address YouTube in order to exercise this.
